## PLAYGROUND UNDER CONSTRUCTION

The playground in the Lou Hartfiel Memorial Park is now under construction. Equipment has been removed to prepare the site for the installation of a state of the art, ADA compliant and all-inclusive play area. The new play area will include a poured rubber surface and the addition of benches which will provide caregivers unobstructed views of their children at play.
