

ORDINANCE 2020-5

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS,
KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY
OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY, TO EXECUTE ON
BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AMENDED INTERLOCAL
AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS,
KENTUCKY, TO EXTEND THE CURRENT INTERLOCAL
AGREEMENT PROVIDING POLICE SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, authorized the Mayor of the City to execute the Interlocal Agreement Between the Cities of Villa Hills and Crescent Springs, in Kenton County, Kentucky, Regarding Police Services (“Interlocal Agreement”), in Ordinance 2017-14, enacted January 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of extending the term of that Interlocal Agreement to allow for long-term planning for the benefit of both the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, and the City of Villa Hills, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the Members of the City Council have reviewed the proposed Amended Interlocal Agreement extending the term of the Interlocal Agreement, and have concluded that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and the legislative body of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, as follows:

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City the Amended Interlocal Agreement extending the term of the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Villa Hills, Kentucky, to provide police services to the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, through June 30, 2030. A copy of said Amended Interlocal Agreement appears as Exhibit “A” and is subject to the

approval of the City of Villa Hills, Kentucky, and the Attorney General or Department of Local Government.
