

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-9

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY, REPEALING CHAPTER 90 OF THE CRESCENT SPRINGS CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING ANIMAL CONTROL, AND ADOPTING, AND INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE, ORDINANCE NUMBER 840.11 OF THE KENTON COUNTY ORDINANCES RELATING TO CHAPTER 90 OF THE KENTON COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES REGULATING ANIMALS

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court has determined that it is beneficial to all residents of Kenton County, Kentucky, to regulate animal population and animal establishments within the County to ensure that animals are treated humanely, controlled by their owners and custodians, and subject to the authority of Animal Control; and

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court has entered into an Interlocal agreement with various cities throughout Kenton County, including the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, regarding the duties of regulating animals within cities, including the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court revised and reenacted its Chapter 90 of the Kenton County Code of Ordinances regulating animals on May 25, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Kenton County has requested that the City of Crescent Springs adopt the exact same Ordinance for the sake of uniformity and application of equal treatment to all residents, including to the residents of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY:

That the existing Chapter 90 of the Crescent Springs Code of Ordinances be and hereby is repealed and replaced by the exact Ordinance enacted by Kenton County on May 25, 2020, bearing Ordinance No. 840.11. Said Ordinance is adopted in its totality and is incorporated herein by reference.

This Ordinance replaces the existing Chapter 90, and any Ordinance, Municipal Order, or other Order to the contrary, in force and effect as of the date of enactment of this Ordinance, is hereby repealed.

In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid, that does not affect the validity of the balance of the Ordinance.
